
THE WEATHER in the Azores is spring-like most of the time; capricious, with days of sun interlaced with low clouds, a shower, a rainbow – and then sun again. Never too cold (seldom drops below 50 during the coldest winter nights) or too hot (rarely rises above 82 during the warmest summer days). Humid and often cloudy. Perfect for the outdoors. See a comparison average temperature and average rain between the Azores, Boston and Bermuda below. Obvioulsy, the Azorean climate is much closer to Bermuda than to Boston!
